Housing

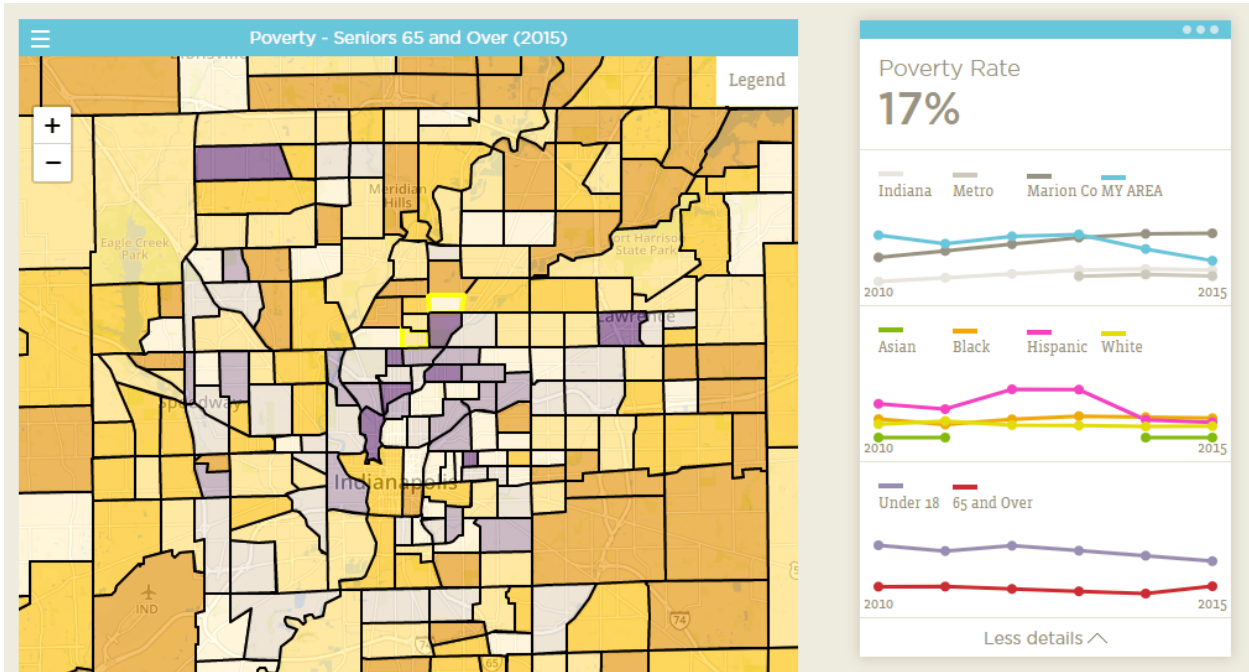
Dwelling units, vacancy, assessed value, building permits, rent, and more.



Economy

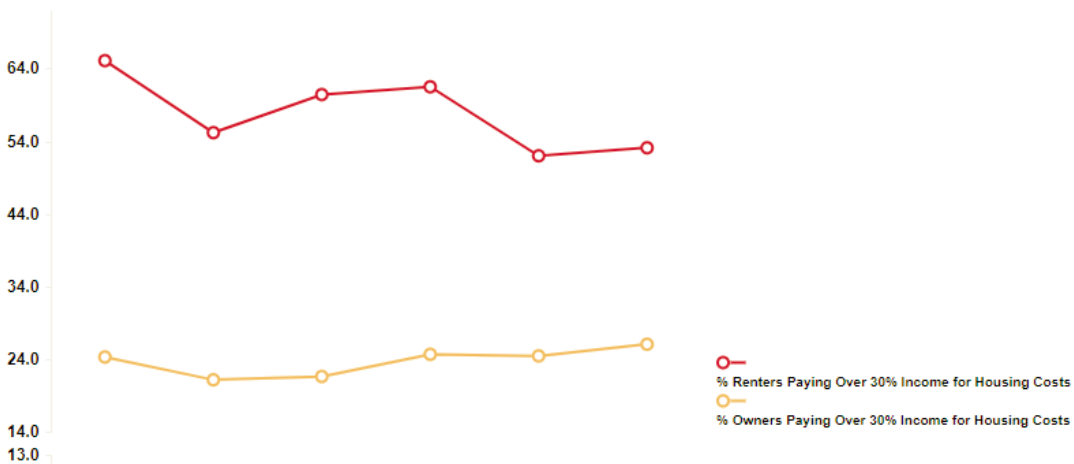
Jobs, unemployment, commercial building permits, and more.
